The Auction Process:

Begins at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 3 at Racine Pavilion

As a prospective buyer, you will be provided with a list of livestock for sale.

As each animal is led into the auction ring, the auctioneer will ask for bids in dollars per pound. You can indicate your interest in purchasing by raising your buyer's card.

If you end up with the winning bid, a runner will present you with an invoice for your signature. On this form, you will select to have the animal butchered for your own use, or to have the carcass resold.

Following the auction, please pay for your purchases in the Livestock Office.

STEERS

weigh between 1,000 to 1,350 pounds live, and yield approximately 500 pounds of processed meat. This can include up to 120 steaks, 35 roasts, and 90 pounds of ground beef, stew meat, ribs, etc.

HOGS

weigh between 220 to 275 pounds live, and yield approximately 140 pounds of processed meat. This can include chops, four shoulder roasts, two sides of bacon, two hams, ribs and sausage.

LAMBS

weigh between 100 to 145 pounds live, and yield approximately 60 pounds of processed meat. This can include up to two legs of lamb, two shanks, spareribs and stew meat.

GOATS

weigh between 60 to 125 pounds live, and yield approximately 40 pounds processed meat. This can include chops, two legs of goat, two shanks, spareribs and stew meat.

Support the Youth:

If you are interested in supporting an exhibitor without buying a whole animal, you can submit a monetary add-on.

Add-ons will be accepted until the conclusion of the auction on Saturday, August 3 at the Livestock office.

Restaurants and Markets: Advertise and serve top quality local meat (depending on processor), and use the 4-H or FFA logo on your menu or displays.
