ABOUT THE SALE – The order of the sale is shown on the following sheets. You will be bidding so many dollars and/or cents per pound, unless otherwise indicated by the auctioneer. After an animal is sold, the clerks will bring you a sales slip for you to indicate how you would like your animal billed and disposed. **PLEASE** indicate one *individual person* to be contacted with *address* and *telephone number*, about the disposition of your purchase. **The party signing the sale invoice will be held responsible for payment. THIS IS A TERMINAL AUCTION.** You have two disposal options:

- 1. Processing** – Animals will be sent to be processed and the carcass is later returned to a place of your designation for cut and wrap.
- 2. Resale** – If you desire to sell your purchased animal back, the auctioneer will announce the resale price you would get prior to the auction. Your cost would then be the difference between that price and what you actually bid. **There will be no Rabbit, Poultry, or Turkey resale**
- 3. Meat Pen Rabbits, Poultry & Turkeys are terminal sales.** There will be NO live pickup. Buyers are responsible for picking up processed meat pens in Ukiah.

ABOUT THE BILLING & PAYMENT – The Savings Bank of Mendocino County provides all clerking services for the auction. These include receipting all buyer payments and distributing those payments to each auction participant in a timely manner. **Payment must be made on the day of the sale**, unless prior arrangements are made. Cash, checks and Visa and MasterCard payments are welcome. Checks are to be made out to “**Redwood Empire Fair Jr. Livestock Auction**”. All **payments** must be made in the Livestock Office. CUT & WRAP – All processed carcasses will be returned to the place of your choice. Please circle your choice on the sales slip. Businesses providing cut-and-wrap services are: 1. 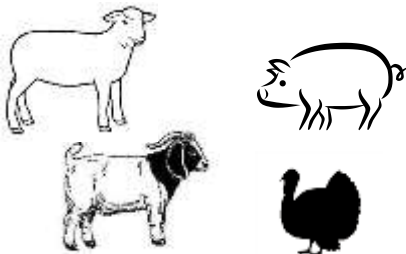
Make your arrangements as soon as possible. You will be billed separately for this service.

PROCESSING – All animals will be harvested at a **USDA Facility: Steers, lambs and goats harvested at Redwood Meat Co.; Swine harvested at Yosemite Meat Co.**

The Rabbit Barn of Turlock will process all rabbit and poultry meat pens. Each carcass will be wrapped whole and frozen. Harvest fees (Rabbit and Poultry Pen \$50.00). Buyers will be contacted for pickup in Ukiah.

Harvest fees for 2022: BEEF-\$175 HOGS-\$75 LAMB-\$65 GOAT-\$65 POULTRY-\$50 RABBITS-\$50 TURKEYS- \$25

These charges will be listed on your sales slip in addition to your bid price.
